

Parish Assembly

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of Trinity was duly convened and held in the Parish Hall on Wednesday 22nd May 2019 at 7.450 pm to:-

1. To consider the following application for recommendation to the Assembly of Governor, Bailiff and Jurats for the year 2019:

2. To agree to the naming of the new parish path recently constructed in field 242 linking the Parish Hall with Le Grand Clos.

3. To record the award of a bar for the Long and Meritorious Service Medal awarded to former Centenier Norman Edward Le Maistre.

The Connétable welcomed the Assembly to the meeting. Apologies were received from Centeniers Mrs S Jones & S Gallichan, Rev G J Houghton, Deputy C H Raymond, Messrs J H Moulin & C S Jones, Vingtenier C Fossey and Mrs A P Le Sueur.

The Minutes of the previous meeting were read and adopted on the proposition of Centenier A Otterwell and seconded by Centenier C D Rook.

1. The Connétable welcomed Laura Kelly, the new owner of Trinity Village Stores, who was applying for a Sixth Category Licence and also a change of name. On the proposition of Mr J Le S Gallichan and seconded by Mr C Bray with all in favour, it was recommended that the application for a 6th Category Licence by Trinity Village Stores be unanimously recommended to the Licensing Bench. Mrs Kelly was warned to attend the Licensing Assembly in the Royal Court on Thursday 20th June 2019 at 10.00 am.

The Connétable thanked Mrs Collette Bisson for her very kind donation of the footpath linking the Parish Hall with Le Grand Clos which he hoped would be the subject for the next Visite Royale to be held in Trinity at a later date. It was proposed that the name for the new path should be 'Lé C'min Le Breton and this was unanimously accepted by all present.

3. The Connétable informed the Assembly that the award of a bar for the Long and Meritorious Service Medal awarded to former Centenier Norman Edward Le Maistre be recorded in the Parish Minutes which was presented to him at Government House by the Lieutenant Governor.

There being no further business, the Connétable declared the meeting closed at 8.00 pm.
