

What would help with greener, safer, travel in Trinity? – Survey Results!

'Our community project board recently asked Parishioners, and those who come to the Parish, their views on the barriers to active travel both in the historic centre and across the parish. We have been delighted with the excellent level of engagement with 321 responses. The responses show that the parish already has an above average bus and cycling usage when compared to other rural Parishes. We hope by making it safer to walk, cycle and travel by bus, we can help towards both the Parishes and the Island's carbon reductions ambitions. The board have asked the technical team to develop a range of options that respond to the concerns raised, particularly at the historic centre of the parish with an aim to consult on these in new year.'
