

PARISH ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of Trinity was duly convened and held in the Parish Hall on Thursday 9th December 2021 at 7.30 pm for the following business:

In accordance with Article 32 of the Rates (Jersey) Law 2005 to elect a member of the Assessment Committee to serve for three years from 1st January 2022, a current member having resigned with effect on 31st December 2021.

Apologies were received from Centenier J Howell.

The Minutes of the previous meeting having been made available in hard copy prior to the commencement of the Assembly were taken as read and adopted on the proposition of Mr R Hassell and seconded by Mrs R Parker.
