PARISH ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of Trinity was duly convened and held in the Parish Hall on Tuesday 13th August 2024 at 7:15 pm for the following business:

- 1. to elect one Constable's Officers for the Vingtaine of Rondin, there being a vacancy.
- 2. to consider the following application for recommendation to the Licensing Assembly:

The Connétable welcomed everyone to the Assembly. Apologies were received from Deputy M E Millar, Deputy H Jeune, the Rector, Mr J Deans, Mr JLeS Gallichan, Mrs D Gallichan and Mrs R Parker.

The Convening Notice was read.

It was noted that the Minutes of the previous Parish Assembly held on 13th June 2024 had been made available to the Assembly in accordance with the terms of the Notice. The Minutes of the Assembly on 13th June 2024 were adopted on the proposition of Mr A Otterwell and seconded by Deputy A Howell.

1. Constable's Officer – Rondin

The Connétable invited nominations for the vacancy.

On the proposal of Mr A Mullins and seconded by Mr A Otterwell, Mr Jamie Rowntree was elected as Constable's Officer. The Connétable congratulated Mr Rowntree on his election and warned him to appear before the Royal Court at 10:00am on Friday 23rd August 2024 to take the oath of office of Constable's Officer.

2. The Connétable invited the company owner to present the company's application to the Assembly. They explained that the business was originally launched two years previously in Gorey. Following growth in the business over the past two years the company had sought larger premises at Woodside Farms. Following the presentation, Mr Simon Gray proposed the application which was seconded by Mrs Anne Pryke. The 28 electors presently at the meeting unanimously agreed to support the application for recommendation to the Licensing Assembly.
