PARISH ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of Trinity was duly convened and held in the Parish Hall on Thursday 13th March 2025 at 7:00 pm for the following business:

- 1. elect a Constable's Officer for the Vingtaine of Rozel, there being a vacancy.
- 2. consider and, if appropriate, approve the sum of £7,000 from reserves to meet the costs of planning fees, bye-law fees and tender/construction fees associated with the proposed extension to the Parish Hall office

The Connétable welcomed everyone to the Assembly. Apologies were received from Deputy E Millar, Mr J Moulin, Procureur, and Centenier S de Louche.

The Convening Notice was read.

It was noted that the Minutes of the previous Parish Assembly held on 13th February 2025 had been made available to the Assembly in accordance with the terms of the Notice. The Minutes of the Assembly on 13th February 2025 were adopted on the proposition of Centenier D Owen and seconded by the Rector.

Constable's Officer – Rozel

Before proceeding to the election of a Constable's Officer, the Connétable thanked Mrs Susan Ingram for her three years' service as Constable's Officer. The Connétable invited nominations for the vacancy.

On the proposal of Mr N Le Maistre and seconded by Mrs A Pryke, Mrs Susan Ingram was re-elected as Constable's Officer. The Connétable congratulated Mrs Ingram on her re-election and warned her to appear before the Royal Court at 10:00am on Friday 4th April 2025 to take the oath of office of Constable's Officer.

2. Fees from reserves

The Connétable referred to the meeting held in December 2024 when the plans for the proposed extension to the Parish Hall were made available. It was noted that, to progress the proposed extension, the architect was required to pay approximately £7,000 to cover planning, bye-law and tender/construction fees. On the proposal of Centenier J Howell, seconded by Mr C Bray, the meeting unanimously agreed that the sum of £7,000 be transferred from reserves to meet the fees.

3.	Having been unable to attend the meeting in December 2024, the Connétable
	presented Mr Alan Cabot with an illuminated address to mark his service to the Parish
	as Constable's Officer from 2008 - 2024. In addition, on behalf of the Bailiff, the
	Connétable presented him with the King's Coronation Medal and read the citation
	from the Bailiff that accompanied it

There being no further business the Assembly was declared closed at 7.14pm.
