

PARISH ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of Trinity was duly convened and held in the Parish Hall on Thursday 11th September 2025 at 7:00 pm for the following business:

1. receive and, if deemed appropriate, approve the minutes of the Parish Assemblies held on 9th June 2025 and 10th July 2025.
2. elect a Vingtenier for the Vingtaine of Rozel, there being a vacancy.
3. elect two Roads Inspectors for the Vingtaine of Augres, there being two vacancies.

In the absence of the Connétable, Mr J Moulin, Procureur, welcomed everyone (27 electors and ratepayers were in attendance) to the Assembly. Mr Moulin informed the meeting that the Connétable had sent his apologies as he had been delayed in the States Assembly which was sitting in to the evening. Apologies were also received from Deputy E Millar, Deputy A Howell, Deputy H Jeune and Deputy K Morel, who were also in the States Assembly, and the Rector, Centenier J Howell, Centenier S de Louche and Vingtenier C Fossey.

The Convening Notice was read.

It was noted that the Minutes of the Parish Assemblies held on 9th June 2025 and 10th July 2025 had been made available to the Assembly in accordance with the terms of the Notice. The Minutes of both Assemblies were adopted on the proposition of Mr N Le Maistre, seconded by Mr C Bray.

1. Vingtenier - Rozel

Before proceeding to the election of a Vingtenier for Rozel, Mr Moulin thanked Ms O Priestley for her service since 2021 both as Constable's Officer and, more latterly, as Vingtenier. Mr Moulin then invited nominations for the vacancy.

On the proposal of Mr A Moss and seconded by Mrs A Le Sueur, Ms O Priestley was re-elected as Vingtenier for Rozel. Mr Moulin congratulated Ms Priestley on her re-election and warned her to appear before the Royal Court at 10:00am on Friday 3rd October 2025 to take the oath of office of Vingtenier.

2. Roads Inspectors - Augres

Before proceeding to the election of two Roads Inspectors Mr Moulin informed the meeting that the vacancies had arisen due to the untimely death of Mr Barry Rondel in June 2025 and the resignation, for personal reasons, of Mr Barrie Dorrington in August 2025.

Mr Moulin informed the meeting that while the Connétable had paid tribute to Mr Rondel at the Parish Assembly in July 2025, he wished to remind all present that Mr Rondel had served as Roads Inspector from 2002 until June 2025.

Mr Moulin went on to inform the meeting that Mr Dorrington served as Constable's Officer from 1989-1999 and was elected as Vingtenier in 2000, a position that he held for three years. In 2009, Mr Dorrington was elected as Roads Inspector and served in that position until August 2025.

Nominations for the vacancies were invited:

On the proposal of Mr N Le Maistre and seconded by Mr A Dunford, Mr Brian Brown was elected as Roads Inspector.

On the proposal of Mr P Bell and seconded by J Deans, Mr Trevor Carter (known as Jim Carter) was elected as Roads Inspector.

Mr Moulin congratulated Mr Brown and Mr Carter on their elections and warned them to appear before the Royal Court at 10:00am on Friday 3rd October 2025 to take the oath of office of Roads Inspector.

There being no further business, Mr Moulin thanked everyone for attending and the Assembly was declared closed at 7.10pm.
