

**PARISH ASSEMBLY**

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of Trinity was duly convened and held in the Parish Hall on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> October 2025 at 7:00 pm to consider the following application for recommendation to the Licencing Assembly:

Address: Trinity Local Store, La Rue ès Picots, Trinity JE3 5JX  
Category of licence: 6<sup>th</sup> Category (Off licence)

The Connétable welcomed those (which included 4 electors and ratepayers) in attendance. Apologies were received from Deputy A Howell, Centenier S de Louche and Mrs A Pryke.

The Convening Notice was read.

It was noted that the Minutes of the previous Parish Assembly held on 11<sup>th</sup> September 2025 had been made available to the Assembly in accordance with the terms of the Notice. The Minutes of the Assembly on 11<sup>th</sup> September 2025 were adopted on the proposition of Mrs A Le Sueur and seconded by Mr J Moulin, Procureur.

The Connétable invited Mrs Sarah Donati-Ford to present the company’s application to the Assembly. Mrs Donati-Ford explained that the company was taking on the lease of Trinity Local Store on 8<sup>th</sup> November 2025 and that it would be the third shop that she had opened. She explained that she intended to sell local produce including vegetables, meat, fish, together with other consumables typically sold in a village shop. Following the presentation, Mr John Moulin, Procureur, mentioned the importance of maintaining the shop for the local community and proposed the application. The application was seconded by Mrs A Le Sueur. The four electors present at the meeting unanimously agreed to support the application for recommendation to the Licencing Assembly.

There being no further business, the Connétable thanked everyone for attending and the Assembly was declared closed at 7.05pm.
