

ECCLESIASTICAL ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish of Trinity was duly convened and held in the Parish Hall on Thursday 22nd May 2025 at 7.30 pm for the following business:

1. Pass the Accounts of the Churchwardens for the Financial Years 2024 -2025.
2. Elect the Officers of the Church for 2025 – 2026.
3. Name a Committee to examine the Churchwardens' Accounts for the financial year 2025 – 2026.

The Rector welcomed the Assembly and opened the meeting with prayers.

The Convening Notice was read out.

Apologies were received from Procureur and Almoner Mr M Powell, Centenier O Simmons, Centenier J Howell, Centenier D Owen, Deputy E Millar, Mr C Chapman and Mrs A Le Sueur.

The Minutes of the previous Ecclesiastical Assembly held on 23rd May 2024 were unanimously adopted on the proposition of Deputy A Howell and seconded by the Connétable.

1. Miss A Le Brun, Churchwarden, outlined the income and expenditure of the Trésor, Charité, Extraordinaire and Le Don de Dlle Chevalier Accounts.
2. The Rector confirmed that all of the Accounts had been inspected and were recommended to the Assembly by the Special Committee.

It was noted that next year, there would probably be a proposal to merge the Charité and the Extraordinaire Accounts, in order to simplify the Accounts.

On the proposition of Mr C Simpson and seconded by Mr C Bray, the recommendations of the Special Committee to the Assembly were duly adopted and the Accounts of the Trésor, Charité, Extraordinaire and Le Don de Dlle Chevalier and Trésor were unanimously agreed.

3. The Rector expressed his thanks to Miss Aynslie Le Brun and Mrs Jo Dawson for their assistance as Churchwardens throughout the year, which thanks were repeated by the Connétable.
4. On the proposition of the Connétable and seconded by Mrs J Powell, Miss A C Le Brun and Mrs J Dawson were re-elected as Churchwardens.

5. The Rector expressed his thanks to Mr A Paine and Mr M Powell for their assistance as Almoners throughout the year.
6. On the proposition of Procureur J Moulin and seconded by Deputy A Howell Mr A Paine and Mr M Powell were re-elected as Almoners.
7. The re-elected officers were warned to attend the Ecclesiastical Court in the Royal Court on Saturday 7th June 2025 at 10.00 am.
8. Mrs R Misson, Mrs M Pittom, Mrs J Powell, Mr C Chaplin and Deputy M E Millar were unanimously re-elected as adjoints of the Special Committee to examine the Churchwardens Accounts for the year 2025 – 2026.
9. Accordingly, the Special Committee for 2025 – 2026 would be constituted as follows:

11. The Connétable thanked the Rector and all Church Officers on behalf of the Parish for all of their hard work for the wider community.

There being no further business, the Rector thanked everyone for attending and closed the meeting with Grace.
