

ELECTORAL ASSEMBLY

An Assembly of the Electors of the Parish of Trinity was held at the Parish Hall at 7:00pm on Thursday 1st May 2025 to elect one Centenier for a 3 year term of office expiring June 2028.

The Connétable welcomed the Assembly to the meeting. Apologies were received from Deputy H Jeune, Deputy S Luce, Centenier O Simmons and Mrs S Ingram.

The Convening Notice was read.

It was noted that the draft Minutes of the previous Electoral Assembly held on 13th August 2024 had been made available to the Assembly in accordance with the terms of the Notice. The Minutes of the Assembly on 13th August 2024 were adopted on the proposition of Mr J Moulin, Procureur, and seconded by Mr C Bray.
